

Important changes to your auto insurance accident benefits

Starting July 1, 2026, Ontario is introducing changes that will give you more options and control over your auto insurance coverage. Here's what you need to know:

- Some accident benefits will become optional. These include income replacement, non-earner benefits, caregiver benefits, lost educational expenses, expenses of visitors, housekeeping and home maintenance, damage to personal items, death benefits, and funeral benefits.
- If you're an existing customer, your policy will automatically renew with your current coverage.
